→ Tactical Reloading →

Don't wait until you're empty—reload before it's too late.

In a real fight, the lull in action is your only chance to top off your weapon. That's where **tactical reloads** come in. You're not out of ammo—you're being smart. You're buying yourself seconds later by spending a second now.

✓ What is a tactical reload?

Swapping a partially used magazine for a full one while retaining the partial. This keeps you in the fight with a topped-off weapon and a backup mag still in your kit.

Why it matters:

- You may not hear or feel when you're down to the last few rounds.
- You never want to hit "slide lock" in the middle of a violent encounter.
- Every second you spend fumbling with an empty gun is a second you're exposed.

Train it until it's second nature:

- Keep your eyes up, not on your gun.
- Retain the used mag—don't just drop it.
- Work it into your dry fire reps and live fire drills.
- Practice during movement, behind cover, under pressure.

This is **about control** of your weapon, your situation, and your mindset. A good tactical reload keeps you ready without compromising safety.

Stay ready. Stay dangerous. Stay alive.
