-  **KEEPS YOU GROUNDED UNDER STRESS**

Ethical thinking reinforces lawful action—helping you stay within the legal use-of-force boundaries.
-  **BUILDS TRUE CONFIDENCE (NOT ARROGANCE)**
Confidence comes from knowing not just how to act—but when restraint is the right call.
-  **DEFINES YOU AS A GUARDIAN, NOT JUST A CARRIER**
Anyone can carry a gun. Not everyone carries responsibility.
